PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

Containing limeflour 55%, magnesium oxide 20% and salt 25% to provide a balanced mineral mix - to use when feeding dairy cows Palm Kernel Expeller (PKE) and PKE blends.

FEEDING RECOMMENDATION

Add Forti-min + Rumensin to PKE or blended feed at a rate of 100g per cow, per day. Please refer to the chart above for recommended addition rates of Forti-Min + Rumensin per tonne of feed, based on amount of feed offered per cow.

NOTE

The above recommendations are based on a 450kg lactating dairy cow. Using the above guidelines, each cow will be delivered 22g elemental calcium, 9g elemental sodium, and 10g elemental magnesium.

DO NOT FEED FORTI-MIN TO DRY COWS AS THIS MAY LEAD TO INCREASED EXPOSURE TO MILK FEVER.
